ENTRY RULES

This form must accompany all entries and be signed by the student artist and a parent or guardian.

All students in Tonganoxie schools, public and private, including home-school students, are welcome to enter. Forms are available at all Tonganoxie schools or The Mirror office.

POSTER THEME AND SIZE

Posters must be of original design and promote the theme of "your vote counts." Submissions should not promote particular candidates. Submissions should be no larger than 19 inches in depth and 10 inches in width.

Poster designs can be submitted in any medium, including watercolor, crayon, pencil, paint or charcoal.

ELIGIBILITY

Any youth age 18 and under is eligible to enter. One winner in each group will be picked. The poster design winners will be published in The Mirror before the November election.

The two age groups for entries are:

- Group 1: K-8th grade - One winner
- Group 2: 9th-12th grade - One winner
