


ACT Composite

2007-2010




SAT Composite






AYP Targets - Reading



AYP Targets - Math




% of Students in Selected Groups




% of Students Scoring Exemplary on Kansas Assessments





All Students (3-HS)




% of Students Scoring Exemplary on Kansas Assessments

Celebrations


- All high schools attained a Standard of Excellence in both reading and math for three consecutive years.






