




# ACT Composite 2007-2010






# SAT Composite 2007-2010




#### AYP Targets - Math




#### % of Students in Selected Groups






## % of Students Scoring Exemplary on Kansas Assessments










## % of Students Scoring Exemplary on Kansas Assessments
