

## **Basehor City Council Applications Are Being Accepted**

The City of Basehor is now accepting applications for appointment to the City Council. Four Council positions are currently available. Two positions have terms that will expire in April of 2013, and the other two in April of 2015. Applications can be obtained at City Hall during regular business hours or on our website at [www.cityofbasehor.org](http://www.cityofbasehor.org).

Interested parties for appointment to the City Council will need to submit the following:

- City of Basehor Application for City Council
- A cover letter indicating your interest and general qualifications for the position
- A resume of no more than two (2) pages
- Answers to the supplemental questions – no more than six (6) total pages

Applicants are required to be full time residents of the City of Basehor. Those appointed must also maintain residency within the city limits at all times during the appointed term.

Applications will be accepted until 12:00 p.m. on March 30, 2012.

On March 19, 2012, the two sitting City Council Members will elect a City Council President among themselves as per K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 15-310. The City Council President will then become Mayor as per K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 15-201, and the Mayor will appoint the remaining open seats on the City Council in accordance with K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 15-201. It is anticipated that two Council Member appointments will take place on March 19 and the remaining two appointments will take place on April 16. Applications received prior to March 16 at 12:00 p.m. will be considered for two appointments to take place on the 19th. All applications received prior to March 30 at 12:00 p.m. will be considered for the remaining two appointments.

Appointment to the Basehor City Council will require your attendance at numerous regularly scheduled and special meetings which occur in the evening, on weekends, and during the weekday. Regularly scheduled City Council meetings are held on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of the month at 7:00 p.m. at Basehor City Hall located at 2620 North 155<sup>th</sup> Street, 66007. Council Members are compensated at a rate of \$100 per pay period with 26 pay periods taking place annually.
