Brothers Market keeps replenishing its shelves as demand from customers remains steady.

Delivery trucks come three times a week these days, with about 65 percent of orders being filled currently as the COVID-19 pandemic continues with fewer restric-

Delivery orders during "normal" time usually are filled at 90-95 percent.

Still, sales are up at the Tonganoxie store, 319 Ridge St.

"The town is supporting us," said manager Rich Swedo.

Swedo said sales are up about 3 percent currently. The store also started serving breakfast, lunch and dinner again alongside the deli.

As that area works to climb back up to pre-

pandemic numbers, some items are flying off the shelves, specifically frozen foods and dairy prod-

"If you have 1 percent of growth, it's really good," Swedo said, adding that customers seem to be shopping locally more instead of venturing out to larger grocery stores or big box stores.

"It's been very good," he said. "We're happy with the way the town is supporting."

The Tonganoxie store is the lone Kansas location for the Brothers Market family of stores. Based in Iowa, the company bought the local store in June 2014. A year later, the remodeled 20,000 square-foot store opened in summer 2015.

The Tonganoxie location employs about 40 people, including the four-member staff in the Ace Hardware portion of

Brothers Market continues to focus on safety during the pandemic. The company mandated about three weeks ago that all employees wear

Plexiglas shields continue to separate customers from employees at checkout stations and the store continues to offer curbside pickup and delivery 9 a.m.-1 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Customers who are 65 and older or others who might have vulnerable health conditions in light of the pandemic still are welcome to early bird shopping 7-9 a.m. Monday through Saturday.

Regular hours are 7 a.m.-9 p.m. daily.

Other items doing well are Traeger grills and accessories, including seasonings for grilling food and the pellet grills. The store offers various grill brands.


