S&S Body Shop, Automotive nears 50 years in Tonganoxie

S&S Automotive and Body Shop has been a Tonganoxie fixture since 1972.

Brothers Jerry and Ronnie Starcher started the family business in what then became the city maintenance shop near Fifth and Main streets before the city built a new shop at its water treatment facility.

S&S moved to what is now the company's automotive shop on East Fourth Street in 1976 and then the business expanded to the east where the body shop now stands.

S&S continues to take elevated sanitation precautions in light of the COVID-19 pandemic. Employees use disinfectant wipes on keys and steering wheels. Vehicles in the body shop also get a full detail when finished with repairs.

Grant Ritchey was practicing dentistry one day a week in Tonganoxie back in 1987.

At the time, he also had his own practice in Lawrence, but worked once a week for longtime Tonganoxie dentist George Hartshorn as an associ-

The next year, Harts-horn decided to sell the practice and left the country to become a missionary dentist. In April 1988, Ritchey

bought the Tonganoxie practice while splitting time at his Lawrence office. In 1998, he sold the Lawrence practice. So, for nearly 35 years,

Ritchey has been practicing dentistry in downtown Tonganoxie at 504 E. Fourth St.


"I fell in love with the town," Ritchey said. The Tonganoxie den-

tist is back seeing patients as many businesses continue to slowly reopen amid the COVID-19 pandemic. "We took seven weeks

off during the shutdown from mid-March to the first week of May," Ritchey said.

The business is gradually opening back up while continuing its heightened regimen of disinfecting and sterilization.

however, is staying busy with a backlog of patients that built up during the shutdown. And, the office contin-

ues to extend its office hours to be more accessible to patients. A patient can be seen as early as 7 a.m. and the office is open until 6 p.m. weekdays. The office has five full-

time staff and a few parttime staffers, including Diane Flewelling, who has been receptionist at Tonganoxie Dental for 27

"We've cultivated these wonderful long-term relationships, so that's what we miss the most about being shutdown," Ritchey said. "We couldn't wait to get back to see everyone."

The longtime local dentist also has built an audience internationally, becoming a bit of a go-to dentist on social media globally. He writes for the wildly popular blog "Science-Based Medicine," and has his own podcast called "The Prism Pod-

terviewed by "Scientific American" and "The New York Times" and has done some dental outreach as part of mission work in Guatemala.

He also continues to provide dental care for three decades and counting here in Tonganoxie.

"Good, high-quality general dentistry in a relaxed caring environment," Ritchey said, describing his practice.






